Through generous funding from the American Gynecological Club and the Gynaecological Visiting Society of Great Britain and Ireland, we are pleased to offer £1,200 to allow the successful recipient of this Fellowship to visit and gain knowledge from a specific centre offering new techniques of clinical management within O&G.

The visit may be from the UK to the USA or vice versa and is available to those in residency/fellowship programmes in O&G in the USA in alternating years. **For the year 2020, only applicants (residents and/or fellows) from the USA are eligible.**

CONDITIONS

- Travel must take place within 12 months of the award being made in October 2020
- The award may only be used for the purpose outlined in your original application
- A detailed report (maximum 1,000 words), including pictures if necessary, must be submitted to the AGC Secretary and the RCOG Awards Administrator within eight weeks after the elective

Applications received after the closing date will not be accepted. Applications submitted on the RCOG website in 2020 will not be accepted.

- A short CV (maximum of 4 pages)
- A signed letter on institution stationery from the department chair indicating that approval is given for UK travel if the fellowship is awarded. This can be scanned in and attached
- Confirmation from the host institution that your visit has been approved and that you will be supervised in the UK by a Consultant in Obstetrics and Gynaecology

The application consists of three sections and can be submitted online, along with the above attachments. An electronic signature is accepted.

Your application will be judged on the following criteria:

- Presentation and planning
- Originality of elective
- Evidence of supervision and support
- Level of involvement
- Benefit to applicant
